



CSHA State Horsemastership Deadlines 2026

Please make certain that the State Chairman RECEIVES the following information NO LATER than the given dates:

April 15th—Name, address, e-mail of Region chair and Vice chair

June 30—Requests for number of Region written tests. Please let me know if you'll be at July Quarterlies or not, so I can have your packet mailed or delivered if you will not be attending.

July 25th—Written tests available for distribution to Region at July Quarterly meeting.

July 29th—Written test, statewide, (last Wednesday of July). start time 5--7:30pm

Aug 1st—Region \$50.00 intent fee to take participants to State

Aug 15th—**Complete list of Region Champions and Reserve Champions; AND Horsemastership State Championship Riders application and intent fee (\$35.00), postmarked by Aug 15th.** Region riding and grooming tests are at Region Chair's discretion, but must be completed prior to State Championship.

Why is the Rider Intent fee and application due (Postmarked) the same day as the complete list of Region Champions and Reserve Champions? Because the State Finals is on Oct 16-17, one week earlier than last year, and the Champion Buckles take time to make. I'd like to be able to award them at the State Awards Banquet on the 17th.
